Nursery Team (6 mos- 2 yrs)

Nursery Adult Lead: The Nursery lead will arrive early, greet the children and parents as they arrive, supervise youth volunteers, and play with children and interact with them throughout the hour. The adult helper will also read a Bible story to the kids.

Nursery Youth Helper: The classroom youth helper will assist the children as needed, model the adults and learn from them.



2s& 3s Team

2s& 3s Storyteller/ Lead: The goal of the 2s&3s Storyteller/ Lead is to unveil the core truth and tell the Bible Story in such a way that it comes alive for a child. Energy, communication skills, friendliness and comfort in front of children are important. Though a script will be provided, preparation time in learning the Bible story is part of this role. The Storyteller/ Lead Teacher will also lead children through learning activities that reinforce the lesson.

2s&3s Helpers: The 2s&3s helper will arrive early, greet the children and parents as they arrive, engage kids in opening activities, sit with the children and interact with them during the story time, and help out in the classroom as needed.

Administration Team

Supplies Team: This team meets weekly to prepare supplies for the Sunday morning program. A love for details is helpful.

Administrative Team: This team helps with administrative tasks that help Children's Ministries run smoothly. Tasks include: database updating, photocopying, and organization.

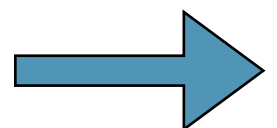
4yrs-Kindergarten Team

Host: The host is the "emcee" of the large group experience. The host has energy, friendliness and comfort in front of children. Preparation time in reading over the script and familiarizing yourself with your role are important aspects of the host position. If you enjoy skits and drama this is for you!

Storyteller: The goal of the storyteller is to unveil the core truth and tell the Bible Story in such a way that it comes alive for a child. Energy, communication skills, friendliness and comfort in front of children are important. Though a script will be provided, preparation time in learning the Bible story is part of this role.

Activity Leader: Helps guide kids through activities and helps them apply the bottom line to their everyday lives. Leads craft, game or snack activity that helps reinforce the bottom line. Curriculum will be provided

Worship Leader: The worship leader will teach the monthly Bible verse and lead music related to the monthly theme during the large group time. The worship leader needs be comfortable singing along to a CD and learning hand motions.



1st- 5th grade Team

Greeter: The greeter stands at the Children's Ministry welcome table and welcomes new families, helps them find their child's class and helps parents and kids sign-in.

Host: host is the "emcee" of the large group experience. The host has energy, friendliness and comfort in front of children. Preparation time in reading over the script and familiarizing yourself with your role are important aspects of the host position.

Storyteller: The goal of the storyteller is to unveil the core truth and tell the Bible Story in such a way that it comes alive for a child. Energy, communication skills, friendliness and comfort in front of children are important. Though a script will be provided, preparation time in learning the Bible story is part of this role.

Worship Leader/ Worship Team: The worship leader and team will help kids connect with God through music and prayer. The worship team will teach kids new songs and movements and help kids learn to worship God.

Tech Team: Is responsible for technical aspects of the large group experience, including sound, video, and computer.

Small Group Leader: Leads small group activities that help kids apply the Bible story to their everyday lives. Connects relationally with ten to twelve kids and speaks truth into their lives and celebrates spiritual growth.



Special Events Team

Love to help throw a party? Like to help plan a big event? This team helps provide leadership for Children's Ministry Special Events such as the Easter Egg Hunt, Christmas Events, and Breakaway! Commitment varies depending on events.

KidStuf Team

Drama Team: Love to act? Then consider auditioning to be a part of our KidStuf drama team. Drama team members meet for 3-4 practices before each KidStuf. Involves memorizing lines and stage blocking.

Worship Team: Love to sing and dance? Then consider helping kids and parents worship God at KidStuf! The KidStuf worship team practices 3-4 times prior to each KidStuf and lead in worship at KidStuf. Leading worship on Sundays a few weeks per month is required.

Tech Team: Love computers? Enjoy running sound or lighting? The KidStuf Tech Team is responsible for all the technical aspects at KidStuf including lighting, sound and video. Training will be provided. Tech team members must be present at our dress rehearsal prior to each KidStuf and at KidStuf.

Production Lead: Love to help put on a show? The KidStuf production team helps produce KidStuf by directing dramas, writing scripts, and/or creating props and set pieces. The Production Team will meet monthly and must be present at KidStuf and the dress rehearsal prior to each KidStuf.
