- If Paul isn't teaching us we are saved by works (which he isn't), what is he saying?

### **Day Two: Phil. 2: 14 – 16**

- Let's get practical; what does "working out your salvation" look like?
- How should we appear to others (verse 15)?
- Why does God do this (hint, verse 16)?

### **Day Three: Example #1, Phil. 2: 17 – 18**

- Who is being talked about in these verses?
- What is saying could happen to him?
- What is his attitude?
- What does he ask the Philippians attitude to be?

### **Day Four: Example #2, Phil. 2: 19 – 24**

- Who is being talked about in these verses?
- What attitude characterizes him (verses 20 & 21)?
- What is his relationship to Paul like?

### **Day Five: Example #3, Phil. 2: 25-30**

- What did he do?
- How does his work compare to Paul or Timothy?
